Driving Directions to the Hampton Inn Hotel & Suites RDU/Brier Creek

From Raleigh-Durham Int'l Airport - Take Aviation Parkway North toward I-540. Exit onto I-540 East toward US 70. Once on I-540, take Exit 3/Lumley Rd. Turn left off exit and make right at first traffic light onto Arco Corporate Dr. Hotel is 3/4 mile on right.

From I-40 - Take Exit 283 for I-540 East toward US 70. Once on I-540, take Exit 3/Lumley Rd. Turn left off exit and make right at first traffic light onto Arco Corporate Dr. Hotel is 3/4 mile on right.

From Downtown Raleigh - Follow US 70 West/Glenwood Avenue (toward Durham) for approximately 12 miles. Turn left at Brier Creek Parkway, keep to left. Make 1st immediate left onto Arco Corporate Drive. Hotel is 1/4 mile on left.

From Wake Forest / Capital Blvd - Route 1, take I-540 West to Exit 4B to US 70 West/Glenwood Avenue. Turn left at 1st light onto Brier Creek Parkway, keep to left. Make 1st immediate left to Arco Corporate Drive. Hotel is 1/4 mile on left.

Cross Streets - North of I-540 and US 70/Glenwood Avenue. Half mile SW of Glenwood Avenue and Brier Creek Parkway intersection.
